Workshop objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recognize the power of little things. 2. Make students aware of their ability to transform the world around them. 3. Motivate youth to take action and change what they don't like about their surroundings.
Before starting this workshop	<p>We'll tell students that in this final workshop in the "For real!!!" guide, we'll look at gender inequalities we experience on a daily basis and decide how to do something about them. We'll let students know that big initiatives aren't the only way to change things: small actions can lead to small-scale changes that kick off a chain reaction.</p> <p>Student's proposals can be extremely diverse: an exhibit (showing drawings, infographics, photographs, materials, texts, videos, websites...), a video, an intervention (a flash mob, dance routine, music, theatre, activities for raising awareness...), or whatever the group prefers.</p>

Activity 2	Possible interventions (20') Find out about awareness-raising activities created by young people.
Activity 3	It's raining inequality (25') Identifying elements of gender inequality.
Activity 4	Selecting an idea and a strategy (25') Decide what to do and how.
